Gas Tumble Dryer Washing Machine Iron	User: Burns and Scalds Toxic Fumes from Gas Slips, trips, falls due to wet or slippery floors. Burns Injury to unauthorised persons entering laundry - child climbing into dryer or washing machine	Equipment is only used by competent persons. Signs displayed to ensure no items are placed on top of dryers or washing machines. Floor are kept clean and free from trip hazards. Users are instructed to clean Dryer filters daily. Gas shut off valves are present within the laundry and on the outside corridor wall. - They are clearly labelled. Iron is switched off when not in use. Laundry equipment is serviced in accordance with manufacturers recommendation annually and PAT tested. No unsupervised young people or children allowed in the Laundry. The laundry door is fitted with a closer in case of fire. Door not to be wedged open. Door to be kept closed when laundry not in use.
