Paint is stored securely. Water based paints used when possible. PPE - Appropriate dust masks, eye protection and gloves are provided. Users to operate in well-ventilated area and ensure no unnecessary other site users are within the work area.	Med	All new work undertaken to be briefed by supervising authorised person. PPE to be worn as appropriate (Mask / Goggles / Coveralls / Gloves)	Low
