No storage over 6ft high. Pallet handling is by a minimum of 2 people.</p> <p>PPE. Appropriate gloves and glasses are provided. Workers will wear suitable clothing and stout footwear.</p> <p>Workers stack wood and clean as they go in work area to prevent slips trips and falls.</p>	Med	<p>All new work undertaken to be briefed by supervising authorised person.</p> <p>Only authorised and competent persons to carry out operations.</p> <p>PPE provided for use as necessary.</p> <p>Ensure all potential wood with nails are lifted from floor, nails removed or knocked in.</p> <p>Carry out regular checks of storage area for safe storage and operation.</p> <p>Area to be clear of unnecessary other site users.</p>	Low
