<p>Use of Hand Axes and saws on Site</p> <p>Including;</p> <p>Bow saw / Hand Axe / Felling Axe</p> <p>Log Splitter</p>	<p>Users.</p> <p>Inappropriate use of tools</p> <p>Slips trips and falls.</p> <p>Injury from tools and injury to bystanders from inappropriate use, tool failure, and flying debris</p> <p>Musculoskeletal injury</p> <p>Injuries by trapping fingers, splinters, dropping logs.</p>	<p>Hand axes and saws are kept secured when not in use.</p> <p>Moving around site tools are transported in a safe manner with safety sheath in position.</p> <p>Only competent persons use axes and saws.</p> <p>PPE. Gloves, safety glasses, masks and suitable footwear available for use.</p> <p>Any tool found to be defective is removed from service for repair or disposal.</p> <p>Axes and saws used in safe chopping areas where possible.</p> <p>Users are given clear instructions in its use.</p>	Med	<p>All new work undertaken to be briefed by supervising authorised person.</p> <p>When using Bow saw, use logging horse, if possible, ensure in good condition prior to use.</p> <p>Any work carried out outside safe chopping area should have a safe zone established around any Axe work.</p> <p>Appropriate demonstration for those unfamiliar with equipment and a health and safety reminder before operating saws, axes and splitter.</p> <p>PPE to be worn as appropriate.</p>	Low
